

STOUGHTON PUBLIC LIBRARY
WIRELESS USE POLICY

I. Purpose

The purpose of the policy is to set forth provisions for wireless access in the library.

II. Use

- A. Patrons using wireless access must agree and adhere to the Stoughton Public Library Internet Acceptable Use Policy.
- B. Wireless access is available only during library hours.
- C. Wireless access may be inaccessible in certain areas of the building.
- D. Wireless access may be interrupted or unavailable at any time.
- E. Wireless access is not secure. Open WiFi connections can be intercepted by others.
- F. Users are responsible for their own connection to the library's wireless network. Staff is not available to assist patrons in connecting their devices to the network.
- G. Printing from the wireless network is not available.
- H. Electrical outlets are available at the study tables on the Mezzanine level of the library and in the meeting rooms. Electrical outlets elsewhere in the library are not available for public use. Outlet covers have been installed and may not be removed.
- I. Access to send messages from E-mail client programs installed on a patron's electronic device is not available.
- J. Bandwidth use, time, and inactivity limits are in effect.

III. Unacceptable Uses of Wireless Access

The library's wireless access may be used only for legal purposes. Unacceptable uses are outlined in the Internet Acceptable Use Policy. Users of the Internet are responsible for all copyright compliance in accordance with Title 17 of the United State Code.

IV. Misuse of Wireless

Misuse or abuse of wireless access may result in loss of library privileges. Illegal uses of computers may also be subject to prosecution by local, state or federal authorities.

The library reserves the right to end a wireless session or restrict a wireless account if they judge it is being misued.
